Subject: Trial Access Activation of SciVerse Scopus (Elsevier)

All faculty members, research scholars & students may kindly note that the free, no obligatory SciVerse Scopus access is up and running now.

SciVerse Scopus is the world's largest abstract and citation database of peer – reviewed literature and quality web sources. The coverage of Scopus is multidisciplinary and includes:

- (1) More than 7200 titles from Physical Sciences
- (2) More than 5300 titles from Social Sciences
- (3) More than 4300 titles from Life Sciences
- (4) More than 6800 titles from Health Sciences

All in all, Scopus includes 41 million records (70% with abstracts), nearly 18,000 titles from 5000 publishers worldwide, 70% content owing its origin to international sources, over 3 million conference papers, 300+ Indian journals and a number of technologically advanced and sophisticated tools to track, analyze and visualize research. In short, Scopus acts as the gateway of information resources that effectively enables the research community to keep themselves updated and abreast with technological advances across the globe.
