Item S-62.2025-III-1.5: Norms for award of degree's to students pursuing five years dual degree B. Tech and M. Tech program under the department of Mathematics Bioinformatics and Computer Applications

A meeting to finalize norms for award of degree's to students pursuing five years dual degree integrated B. Tech and M. Tech program under the department of Mathematics Bioinformatics and Computer Applications, was conducted on 8th August 2025 and recommended the following:

- a. The student who completes the dual; degree B. Tech. and M. Tech. program in Mathematics and Data Science in stipulated time (i.e. 05 years) shall be awarded two degrees.
 - i) B. Tech. in Mathematics and Data Science
(As partial fulfillment of the five year *B. Tech. and M. Tech.* Dual Degree Program)
 - ii) M. Tech. in Mathematics and Data Science
(Under five year *B. Tech. and M. Tech.* Dual Degree Program.)
- b. The students of Dual Degree Program B. Tech. and M. Tech. in Mathematics and Data Science can opt complete exit after completing 04 years those students shall be awarded single degree i.e.
 - i) B. Tech. in Mathematics and Data Science
(Under five year B. Tech. and M. Tech. Dual Degree Program.)
- c. A student who exits after two years as per NEP 2020 guidelines, shall be awarded a
 - i) Diploma in Mathematics and Data Science.
(Under five year B. Tech. and M. Tech. Dual Degree Program.)


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- d. A student who takes temporary exit as per NEP 2020 guidelines after 02/04 years and wants to join back the program within stipulated time as per ordinance, shall be awarded single / dual degree after completion of 04/05 years.

Decision: The proposals of the above three departments are approved. The curriculum of all three departments are highly industry-focused, aiming to bridge the gap between academic knowledge and


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the practical skills required by the modern manufacturing sector. The key verticals/modules proposed for integration into the curriculum were:

- 1. Smart Manufacturing (or Advance Manufacturing / Robotic Automation)*
- 2. Robotics and Automation (or Robotics)*
- 3. Electronics*
- 4. IOT (Internet of Things)*
- 5. Mechatronics*
- 6. E-mobility*

These departments presented their revised schemes duly approved by their BOAC which included different modules and the project components of the corresponding verticals. Increase in number of credits are in the range 160 to 180 is approved.

The department of Mechanical Engineering and Energy Science & Engineering had modified their scheme as per Verticle-1 and 6 respectively in their existing B. Tech. program by including the modules offered by Bajaj Auto Limited is approved.

The department of Electrical Engineering has offered a new B. Tech. program in “Electrical Engineering with e-Mobility” with an intake of 30 (Thirty) seats. These 30 seats will be taken out from sanctioned strength (136 seats) of B. Tech. Electrical Engineering course run by them is approved.

The Bajaj Auto will setup the State of Art Laboratory Infrastructure for the verticals, the departments has opted to include in the existing / new course curriculum is approved.

Item S-62.2025-III-2.5: Proposals from Physics Department for commencement of one new UG course - B. Tech. in Engineering Physics and one new PG course – M. Tech. in Semiconductor and Quantum Technology in lieu of existing M. Tech. Nano Technology, w.e.f. academic session 2025-26

As per the directions of Senate in the 61st senate meeting held on 23.07.2025. HOD Physics have conducted a meeting with Heads of Mechanical, ECE and CSE departments and with Dean Academic on 15.09.2025 and revised the scheme.

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- b) *In principle B. Tech. in Engineering Physics is approved, with a condition that no extra faculty shall be provided by the Institute. Further, the intake of the students in this program shall be decided in consultation with the Department of Civil and Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering. If these two departments agree to provide the seats from the existing intake of their B. Tech. course, then with the intake of 30 (thirty) students, program on B. Tech. in Engineering Physics shall be started.*

Item S-62.2025-III-2.6: Minutes of Standing Committee Meeting, held on 19.09.2025 to discuss the request to conduct supplementary examinations during Middle of the semester

The representation received from Mr. Ayush Singh, President, Student Council and also applications received from individuals (B. Tech. students of various branches) of VI semester, regarding conduction of middle of the semester supplementary examination, asking that if the special supplementary exam is not conducted then they may be deprived of campus interviews.

As per the academic calendar (2025-26) Odd - Even supplementary examination is scheduled in November - December 2025.

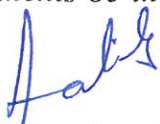

Item S-62.2025-III-2.8: Proposal for implementation of relative grading system w.e.f. session 2025-2026

As per 61th Senate decision vide agenda Item S-61.2025-I-2.13, the Grade committee was directed to do more exercise and put the matter in the forthcoming senate meeting.

In this regard the inclusion of classes having fewer than 20 students in the relative grading system, it is to mention that applying a Gaussian (bell curve)–based grading system is not statistically feasible for small datasets or classes with a limited number of students (less than 20 students). **The relative grading approach assumes a normal distribution of marks, which requires a sufficiently large sample size to ensure fairness.** In small classes, the distribution of marks can be **highly skewed**, and the resulting grades may not accurately reflect individual performance levels.

Therefore, it is more appropriate to use a **hybrid model** (relative for a large number of students and absolute for less than 20 students) that maintains fairness for both types of classes.

Decision: Effective from session 2026-27, the relative grading criteria to calculate the upper and lower limits for each grade is approved. Item S-62.2025-III-2.9: Request for Revision of Fee Structure for M.Sc. courses offered by the Institute

A proposal received from Energy Science and Engineering department to revise and reduce the fee structure of MSc Energy Economics and Management. In this regard it is to mention that MoE (the then MHRD) vide order F no. 33-4/2014-TS.III dated 5th May 2014 has ordered that the tuition fee for all M.Sc. and PhD program per year be Rs.15,000/-. However at MANIT a committee was constituted

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to review the fees of all programs. The committee recommended that for all PG programs including MSc, the tuition fee shall be Rs.35,000/- per semester which was approved in 49th senate meeting and 47th FC vide communication no. FC47th-2022(1)/6/32 dated 15.06.2022. Rs.35,000/- per semester is the tuition fees charged currently from MSc students.

It is requested that, the senate may reduce the tuition fees to Rs.15,000/- per annum for all MSc and PhD programs run by the Institute as per above MoE (the then MHRD) order.

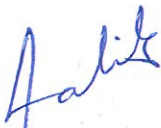

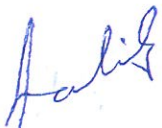
