Please find attached herewith a parliament Rajya Sabha Starred Question on the captioned subject with their responses.

(a) the key reforms under National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 that have been implemented so far;

Response (a): MANIT Bhopal has adopted several NEP-2020 driven curriculum reforms as follows:

- (1) Teaching in Hindi medium: Since 2021, one section (~10 % of B.Tech. first year seats) is exclusively reserved for students choosing Hindi as the medium of instruction.
- (2) Elective credits: All first year UG students choose two electives from Life Skills Management, Physical Health Education, Yoga, or National Service Scheme.
- (3) NCC extra credits: Students enrolled in NCC receive up to 24 extra credit points
- (4) Minor specialization options: In some branches like CSE, ECE, Mechanical, students can take minor subjects and earn up to 18 credits if chosen from semester III onward .
- (5) New core courses: Since the 2020 batch, Engineering Management, Entrepreneurship, Design, and Data Structures are integrated into all B.Tech programmes.
- (6) Internships and NPTEL credit options: Semester long internships in B.Tech./M.Tech and department approved NPTEL courses now fulfill academic credit requirements
- (7) MANIT Bhopal is registered with the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) and engaged in facilitating credit transfers; postgraduate and undergraduate degree credentials are uploaded digitally to NAD/Digi Locker since 2022. Approximately 95% ABC ids were created for MANIT students.
- (8) Multiple entry-exit provisions: a student may exit after two years with a diploma, and return within five years to complete B.Tech or PG programmes. Time spent during exit does not count towards permitted duration.

(b) The timeline for full-scale implementation at the school and university levels; and

Response (b):

Period	Key Developments at MANIT Bhopal
2020–21	Launch of new core courses; credit system restructuring; ABC registration begins
2021	Hindi medium section launched; minor specializations available for UG students
2022–2023	Internship requirements, NPTEL credit options; ABC integration and diploma exit-entry policies activated
July 2023	NEP awareness workshop and video outreach; institutional reflection sessions
By mid-2025	Continued curriculum review by departmental Boards of Academic Council Encouragement of interdisciplinary and project-based learning through BOAC

MANIT’s NEP alignment is now well into **medium phase**, with foundational reforms established and institutional practice consolidated.
