It is informed that out of total sanctioned Non-Faculty posts, almost half the nos. of posts are fall under the Promotion quota as per Recruitment Rules for NITs from time to time and the OBC reservation is not applicable under Promotion quota. The effect of this reason is showing in the table in which the OBC reservation post are way higher than the actual In-position OBC employees. As on date there are total 391 nos. Non-Faculty posts sanctioned to our Institute, out of which 166 nos. of posts comes under the direct recruitment quota and 204 no. of posts comes under the promotional quota. Hence, the OBC reservation is applicable to only 166 nos. of direct recruitment quota of posts as per cadre structure of various posts. The reservation rosters of all the posts are maintained by the Institute and the reservation norms are fully adhered while maintaining reservation rosters.

In posts where L model replacement roster is followed, initial reservation is considered.
